

"D" Card

One "D" card was punched for every farm and ranch schedule. This card provided for the punching of fractions (eighths) of a ton of commercial fertilizer. The tenure, size, and color codes, and field 21 were reproduced from card "A."

Agriculture - Census of 1940. Table for card D showing farm labor, farm expenditures, and cross-line acreage. Columns include Farm Labor (Hired, Other), Farm Expenditures (Feed, Imp. and Mach., Gasoline, Bldg. Material, Fertilizer, Liming Mat'l's), and Cross-Line Acreage (Tenure, Size, Color). Rows represent individual farms with data points like 10, 10, 1, 1, 1, 1, etc.

"E" Card

One "E" card was punched for every farm and ranch schedule having entries for horses, mules, cattle, dairy products, sheep, or hogs.

Census of 1940. Table for card E showing livestock and dairy products. Columns include Horses and Mules (Total, Colts), Cattle (On Hand, Milk and Butter), Dairy Products Sold (Whole Milk, Cream, Butter), Sheep (On Hand, Shorn), and Hogs (Total, Sows). Rows represent individual farms with data points like 1, 1, 1, 1, etc.

"F" Card

One "F" card was punched for every farm and ranch schedule reporting specified animals butchered, goats, or specified livestock purchased or sold.

Census of 1940. Table for card F showing livestock sales and purchases. Columns include Farm Slaughter (Cattle, Calves, Hogs, Sheep), Goats (On Hand, Mohair Clipped), Livestock Purchases (Cattle, Calves, Hogs, Sheep), and Livestock Sales (Cattle, Calves, Hogs, Sheep). Rows represent individual farms with data points like 1, 1, 1, 1, etc.

"G" Card

One "G" card was required for every farm and ranch schedule having entries for poultry, for bees or honey, or for fur animals. If two or more kinds of "Other poultry" were reported additional cards were required. The kind of "Other poultry" reported was indicated by an item punch in column 43. If additional cards were

required because of more than one kind of "Other poultry" reported, these additional cards were punched "1" in column 44 to indicate that they were trailer cards. The other cards were punched "X" in this column. All trailer cards were punched "X" in all numbered fields except 7 and 8.

"H" Card

"H" cards were required for reports of corn, sorghums, oats, or wheat, a separate card being required for each crop. The item punch, column 13, identified the particular crop being punched. This card provided for

the punching of fractions (eighths) of acres in field 10 in order to take care of reports of fractions of acres of sweet sorghums for sirup.

"J" Card

"J" cards were required for reports of small grains (other than oats or wheat), hay, and clover and grass seed. A separate card was required for each kind of small grain, each kind of hay, and each kind of clover or grass seed, each crop being identified by an item punch. In order to ascertain the number of farms reporting any of

the small grains other than oats and wheat a digit "1" was punched in field 1 for the first small grain reported and an "X" was punched in this field for each succeeding small grain reported on that schedule. Similarly, a "1" was punched for the first hay crop reported and for the first clover or grass seed reported.

"P" Card

One "P" card was required for every farm and ranch schedule. The major-source code and fields 1 to 10, inclusive, were punched from the schedule. The major source was coded on the schedule by encircling the largest of the value-of-products entries or by entering a "V," if "0" values only were indicated, or an "X" if the reports for value of products were not usable. Fields 11, 12, and 13 were secured mechanically by cross footing the

other items by means of the multiplying punch. The value code, column 65, was gang punched after sorting the cards on field 11 to array them by total value of products. Card columns 1 and 2, instead of being used for indicating the card, were used for a two-digit value-of-products code, and were gang punched at the same time as the single column value-of-products code.

"Q" Card

"Q" cards were required for every farm and ranch schedule reporting any acreage in the farm as located in minor civil divisions other than where the farm was enumerated. If there were reports of cross-line acreage in two or more minor civil divisions a separate "Q" card was punched for each. Alphabetical punching was used for the M.C.D., county, and State in which the cross-line acreage was located. Otherwise it would have been necessary to search out the numerical codes for each M.C.D., county, and State in order to enter them on the schedules. The first card punched for each schedule was punched "X" in column 73. Each additional, or trailer, card was

punched "1" in this column. The total land in the farm, field 1, was carried on all the cards for a schedule. The trailer and special control punches were used to prevent duplications of this acreage in the tabulations. These special punches, when required, were entered in columns 75, 76, and 77 at the time of the critical examination of the "Q" card tabulations by place of enumeration, Result Slip 58. These additional controls were required to prevent duplication of the total land in farms when the cards were tabulated by location of the cross-line acreage, Result Slip 59.
