¹ Not available.² Schedule inquiry for 1939 specified small grains cut for hay; for 1929, small grains cut for hay and forage, including silage; for 1919, small grains cut green for hay; and for 1909, grains cut green for hay.³ For 1929, combination of "All other tame or cultivated grasses cut for hay" and "All other hay and forage crops."⁴ For 1919 and 1909, vegetables harvested for sale other than cabbage, carrots, celery, and turnips included with vegetables grown for home use.⁵ Schedule inquiry for 1929 specified cabbages and cauliflower.⁶ Less than 1 acre reported.⁷ For 1909 and 1899, value of potatoes harvested.⁸ For 1919, value of all small fruits harvested.⁹ In 1939, apples were reported by 13 farms and cherries and plums by 4 farms. In 1929, kind not specified.
