¹ Figures for cropland harvested and specified crops relate to the crop years 1944, 1939, 1934, 1929, 1924, and 1919.² Total acreage of crops for which figures are available, except that corn cut for forage was excluded, as most of this was probably duplicated in acreage of corn harvested for grain.³ Includes calculated value of corn for grain, silage, fodder, and corn hogged off or grazed.⁴ Includes calculated value of sorghums for grain, silage, hay or dry forage, and sorghums hogged off or grazed.⁵ Includes sorghums for grain and sorghums for seed, which were reported separately in 1920.⁶ Dry lima beans included with all dry field and seed beans.⁷ Includes blackeyes for 1945 and 1940; includes dry lima beans for earlier years.⁸ Excludes reports for farms reporting acreage grown for all purposes with no production.
