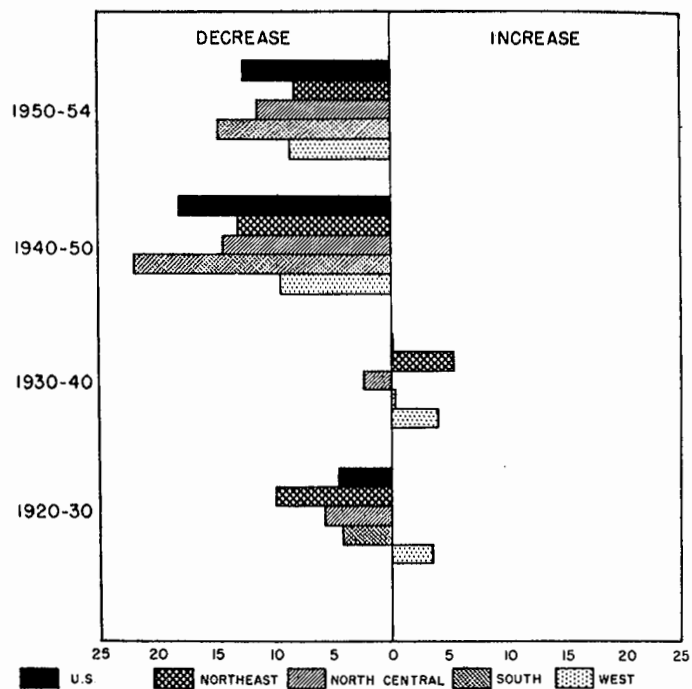
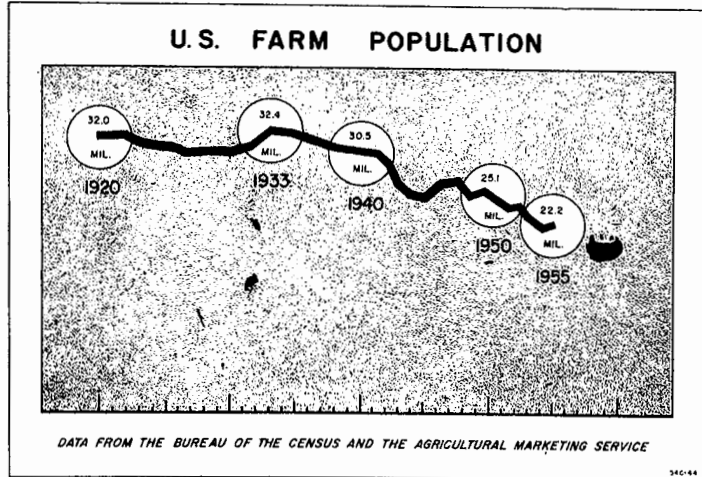


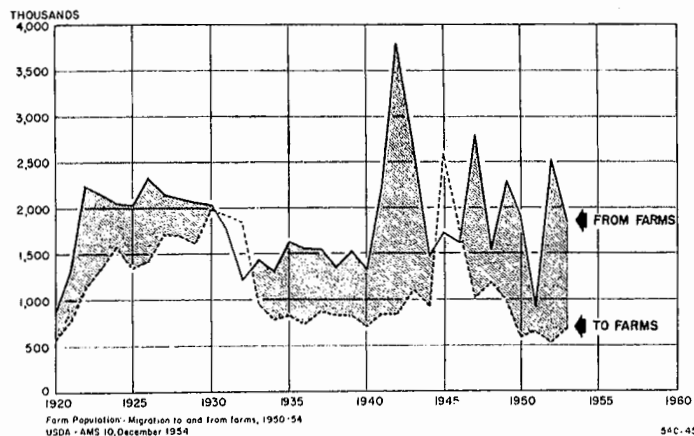
PERCENTAGE CHANGE IN THE FARM POPULATION, SELECTED PERIODS, UNITED STATES AND REGIONS, 1920-54

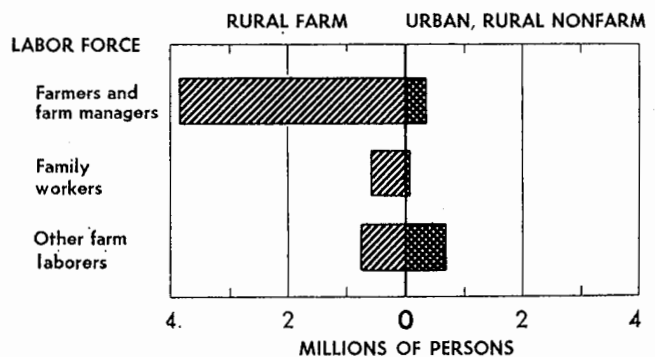


MIGRATION TO AND FROM FARMS, U.S.: 1920-53



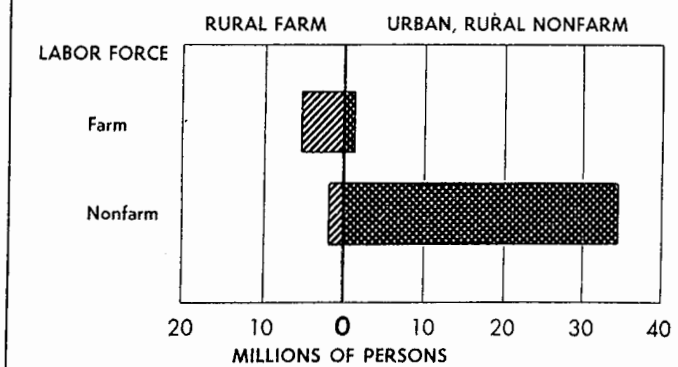
