

## EXPENDITURES FOR HIRED LABOR: 1869 TO 1959



The changes in the amount of expenditures from census to census reflect changes in price level as well as actual changes. The

following table provides figures on the amount of expenditures reported in the census and the amount of those expenditures adjusted to 1959 price level by the use of the U.S. Department of Agriculture index numbers of prices paid by farmers for these items. The figures at constant (1959) prices indicate more accurately the change in amounts of farm expenditures than do the figures reported at current prices in the census.
