



Goats and Mohair.—In 1959, goats were enumerated in 11 States—Alaska, Arizona, California, Hawaii, Missouri, Nevada, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Oregon, Texas, and Utah. The inquiry was as follows: “How many goats and kids of all ages are on this place?”

In the nine States of the conterminous United States the total was further classified as Angora or other goats. The number of goats and kids clipped and the quantity of mohair (in pounds) was also obtained for these nine States.

The number of milk goats was obtained only for Alaska. The value of goat milk sold was obtained only for Hawaii.
