Changes in the number of farms reported for the "Under-10acres" group between census years may be attributed to changes in the agricultural operations on these places, to changes in census definition of a farm, and to changes in the relative completeness of the census. Places in this group may have sufficient agricultural production to be counted as farms at one census, and at another, they may have too limited production to be included as farms. In many cases, such places have small agricultural operations as they represent rural residences.
