⁴For 1909, vegetables other than Irish and sweet potatoes were reported by 4,969,539 farms. Vegetables were not classified as raised for sale or home use. Of the farms reporting, 707,763 had reports of acreage or value, and of those reporting value, 4,220,045 had less than \$500 each, with a total value of \$156,152,564. Data for vegetables raised on tracts of 1 acre or more are given under "Vegetables harvested for sale." The figures shown do not include all vegetables raised for sale, since the aggregate of market vegetables produced on tracts less than 1 acre must have been considerable.

⁵In 1924, only 5 vegetables were specified on the schedule, viz. green beans, cabbage, sweet corn, tomatoes, and watermelons. In 1924, cantaloups and muskmelons, lettuce, and onions (dry) were harvested for sale from 278,550 acres. For 1924, information not obtained for vegetables other than those for which data are given.
