## WHY HAVE WE CALLED ON YOU?

The purpose of this survey is to collect specialized information needed for analysis and understanding of the changes which have occurred so rapidly in American agriculture during recent years. This survey is part of the Census of Agriculture; however, in order to save money, we are collecting this information from only a sample of farms. These items are related for the most part to the financial aspects of the agricultural operations covered in the regular report form that was sent about a year ago to all persons associated with agriculture in 1969.

You are being asked to cooperate in this important survey by providing up-to-date information about agricultural debts, assets, expenditures, taxes, and income. These questions are being asked of a representative cross section of approximately 1 out of every 30 persons on the agriculture census mailing register. The information you provide will be used only in combination with the information provided by others who received this report form. These totals will reflect the financial condition of agriculture for your State for the year 1970, and provide a sound statistical basis for future planning.

It is true that information of the kind asked for in some of the items is available from other sources (such as banks, insurance companies, etc.). But it is also true that much of the needed information can be obtained only by adding together answers provided by you and other persons directly associated with agriculture. You are the best source because you are the only single source from which all the needed information can be obtained.

# Section 4 - DEBTS AS OF DECEMBER 31, 1970

Continuing changes in agricultural practices have increased the amount of money and credit required. This section on debts owed by farmers and ranchers, is to measure today's agricultural credit requirements, and to get a more complete picture of the agricultural debt situation.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The debts to be reported are those owed as of December 31, 1970, arising from the ownership or operation of the acres in this place (section 2, item 4).

For debts covering more land than the acres in this place, report your estimate of that part of the debt applying only to this place. The share to be reported should be estimated in proportion to the market values of the properties. If you cannot allocate debt between owned land reported in section 2, item 4, and owned land rented to others, report the total debt for owned land, and explain in Remarks on page 7. Other debts should also be prorated if they relate only in part to the agricultural operations on this place.

Do not include any of the following kinds of debts:

- Debts of farm property rented to others
- Debts on nonagricultural property such as cotton gins, canning factories, sugar mills, motels, stores, etc.
- Price support loans owed to the Commodity Credit Corp.
- Your landlords' share of any debts
- Charge accounts that are paid in full monthly
- (Debts owed for less than 30 days should not be reported.)

For each source to which no debt was owed on December 31, 1970, mark (X) the small box in the "None" column.

**Column 1, Total debts owed** - For each source of credit, the entry for column 1 should be equal to the sum of the debts reported in columns 2 and 3. If all of the debt from a source is secured by real estate, the entry in this column should be the same as the entry in column 2. Likewise, if none of the debt is secured by real estate, the entry should be the same as for column 3.

**Column 2, Debts secured by real estate** - For each source, report as of December 31, 1970, the amount of debt that was secured by all or part of the real estate in this place. Include debts secured entirely by real estate mortgages (first, second, or third), deeds of trust, and land purchase contracts. Also include in this column debts secured in part by the real estate in this place and in part by chattel mortgages or liens on livestock, poultry, equipment, or crops.

**Column 3, Other debts** - For each source, report as of December 31, 1970, the amount of debt arising from the operation of this place that was not secured by real estate. Include unsecured debts and debts secured entirely by chattel mortgages and crop liens. Also include unpaid bills and accounts which you owed for a period of more than 30 days, as of December 31, 1970.
