Data shown for equipment items manufactured 5 years or more prior to the census year (5 years old or older) for 1969 and 1974 are not fully comparable due to some misreporting in the 1969 census. The design of the machinery and equipment sections for 1969 required respondents to report selected items either as "number manufactured in 1965 or later" or "number manufactured in 1964 or earlier." A number of farm operators reported all of their machinery and equipment inventories as "manufactured in 1965 or later," thus overstating the number of pieces manufactured in the 5 years prior to the census. In 1974, the inventory of machinery and equipment regardless of year of manufacture was requested first and then those manufactured in the 5 years prior to the census year. This change in the question format accounts, in part, for the change in ratio of machinery and equipment manufactured in the 5 years prior to the census year from 43 percent in 1969 to 37 percent in 1974 for motortrucks and 30 percent in 1969 to 20 percent in 1974 for tractors.
