part-time farms if their occupation was other than farming. Corporation and "other" farms such as cooperatives, estates, or trusts, etc., were not classified as to the occupation of the person in charge.

The farm classification of corporations was based upon the percentage of gross business income received from the sale of agricultural products. Those receiving 50 percent or more from the sale of agricultural products were classified as primary farms and those with less than 50 percent were classified as business-associated farms.

Off-farm work—Information about offfarm work by farm operators was first collected for the 1930 Census of Agriculture and similar information has been obtained in each subsequent census. The off-farm work practices of farm operators varies from the supplementation of farm income with spare-time jobs to those operators who have regular nonfarm jobs and use the farm to supplement their primary income and to serve as a place of residence.

The 1974 and the 1969 data are tabulated for operators working one or more days off the farm. In 1969, no distinction was made between farm operators reporting none and those not reporting. In 1974 and some previous censuses, this distinction was made, and in others this category was omitted entirely from the tables. For more detailed information on previous censuses see Volume II, General Report, for the respective census year.

Data for days of work off the farm for both the farm operator and the persons in the operator's household are presented in Volume I, State and County Data, for the individual States. Volume I also contains data on the number of operators whose off-farm income in 1974 exceeded the value of agricultural products sold.

Tenure—The tenure data presented in this chapter are limited to age and year began operation. Tenure by race and other operator characteristics are shown in chapter I of this part.

Characteristics of Farm Operators

Residence of farm operator—In 1974, 80.2 percent of the farm operators reported residing on the farm operated. About 17.8 percent (405,000) operators did not report place of residence com-

pared with 10.6 percent in 1969. Of those reporting, 84.8 percent in the North and slightly less than 75 percent in the South resided on the farm operated. Between 1969 and 1974, the on-farm residency for all farms decreased by only 1 percent while that for farms with sales of \$2,500 and over decreased 3 percent.
