

APPENDIX A. General Explanation

TAKING THE CENSUS

The 1978 Puerto Rico Census of Agriculture was conducted largely by enumerators assigned to specific geographic areas. In rural areas they were instructed to visit every household and/or dwelling (living) unit; in urbanized areas they were instructed to make inquiries of knowledgeable people to find persons conducting agricultural operations. To assist in obtaining as complete an enumeration as possible, enumerators were provided with detailed maps and aerial photographs of their assigned areas. They were also given a Listing Book for each enumeration district (ED) or areas to be canvassed. The book was used to record names, addresses, and additional data for each location visited, and whether or not a questionnaire was filled out. It also provided the enumerator with a series of questions. By asking these questions the enumerator could determine whether the housing unit was located on a place with sufficient agricultural operations to qualify as a farm according to the census' definition. When a place was located which qualified as a farm, the enumerator noted it in the Listing Book and completed a census report. When a place was located which required a census report on which the operator did not live, the enumerator entered the appropriate information for the place on a special form. This information was transferred to another enumerator assigned to the area where the operator lived, who was then responsible for obtaining a completed report for the operation.

A Farm Identification Survey of known large farms was conducted in April, 1978. Data from this survey were used to screen and update a special farm mail list. Farm operators appearing on this list were mailed a report form in June with a request to complete the form and return it. Nonrespondent cases were followed-up by trained enumerators to ensure that all farms on the special mail list were enumerated. In 1974, these farms accounted for approximately 83 percent of the total value of all sales from agricultural products.

OFFICE PROCESSING

During the office processing at the San Juan central office, the report forms were checked in and reviewed for completeness by a clerical staff, during which relevant notes were reviewed and major problems were referred to professional analysts for solution. Reports of large farms were reviewed individually by agricultural economists or statisticians. Incomplete reports, gross inconsistencies, and other problems that could not be resolved by reference to other information on the report forms were resolved by telephone or assigned to special field enumerators for completion and verification.

The report forms were shipped from Puerto Rico to the Bureau of the Census in Suitland, Md., where they were further reviewed and prepared for keying. The report forms were then

shipped to the Census Operations Office in Jeffersonville, Ind., where the data were keyed to magnetic tapes. The tapes were then returned to the Bureau of the Census where they were subjected to a detailed item-by-item electronic computer program edit for consistency and completeness. When data were inconsistent or missing, the computer program either corrected the error or printed a code that indicated the type and location of the problem. These data were individually reviewed for accuracy and corrected, if necessary.

Following the review and verification of the data for accuracy, the data were tabulated by the computer. The tabulated data were reviewed again by statisticians and agricultural economists for consistency, completeness, and possible disclosure of information for individual farms. Final corrections were made at this point prior to publication.

CENSUS COVERAGE

Quality control of the data was monitored by a team of special trained enumerators. The data assembled from this census can only be characterized as being as accurate as reported. A complete and fully accurate account of farms, farmland, and farm production is the aim of each census. The complex structure of Puerto Rico's agriculture makes the aim difficult to achieve.

Many large multilocation farms that have operations in more than one municipio submitted a combined report for the overall operation. The data from these farms were tabulated in the municipio where the farm headquarters is located, substantially increasing figures for some municipios and decreasing figures for others. Many tracts of land that did not qualify as farms consisted of abandoned farms being held for development and land speculation. Several factors have resulted in increased land speculation in Puerto Rico. These include: Expansion of tourist facilities, airport development, urban and industrial development, and the emigration of farm population to urban areas in search of better paying jobs and living conditions.

DEFINITIONS AND EXPLANATIONS

The following definitions and explanations relate to items which are not fully described in the tables. Most of the definitions come from the report form and the instructions to the enumerators. For an exact wording of the questions and instructions for answering the questions, see appendix B.

Operator—The term "operator" designates a person who operates a farm, either doing the work himself or directly supervising the work. This person may be the owner, a member of the owner's household, a hired manager, or tenant, but the person cannot be an agregado or a sharecropper (see definitions). If the

person rents land to others, the person is considered the operator only of the land retained for personal use. In the case of a partnership, only one partner is counted as the operator. The number of farm operators is the same as the number of farms.

Farms—Figures for “farms” represent the number of farms (or operators) reporting a specified item. If a municipio contained 1,200 farms but only 300 farms had cattle and calves on hand as of July 1, 1978, the figure for “farms” for the item “cattle and calves” would be 300. This definition is the same as “farms” in the 1974 and 1969 censuses, and is equivalent to the term “farms reporting” in the 1959 and prior censuses. Where applicable, figures are given for the number of farms (or operators) not reporting items when the intent was to report data for all farms, e.g., place of residence of the operator.

Land area—The approximate land area of Puerto Rico is 2,254,365 cuerdas. A cuerda is equivalent to 0.9712 of an acre or 0.3930 of a hectare. A centesimo is one-hundredth of a cuerda.

Land in farms—This item includes land used for crops, pasture, or grazing; also woodland and wasteland not actually under cultivation nor used for pasture or grazing, provided it was part of the operator’s total operation. Woodland or wasteland held for nonagricultural purposes were to be excluded.

Land in farms is an operating unit concept and includes land owned and operated as well as land rented from others. Land used rent free was to be reported as land rented from others.

Land owned (full and part owners)—This item includes all land that the operator owned, his wife or both held under title, purchase contract or mortgage, or as heir or trustee of an undivided estate at the time of the enumeration. Land operated by a *hired manager* covers all tracts of land managed for one or more employers by a person hired for a salary. Land managed by a hired manager was also considered owned. A hired manager was considered to be the operator of the land he/she managed because this person was responsible for the agricultural operations on the land and frequently supervised others in performing those operations.

Land rented from others (tenants)—This item includes all land that the operator rented or leased from others or used rent free.

Land rented to others—This item includes all land rented or leased to others for cash or a share of the crops or livestock, and land rented from others and then subleased to others.

Land in two or more municipios—An individual farm was counted in only one municipio even if the land was located in two or more municipios. The land in each farm was tabulated as being in the operator’s principal municipio. The principal municipio was defined as the one where the largest value of the agricultural products was raised or produced. It was usually, but not always, where the operator reported all or the largest part of the total land.

Land use—Land in farms was classified according to the way it was used during the period between July 1, 1977, and June 30, 1978. This classification includes three major groups: (1) cultivated cropland, (2) land in pasture, and (3) other lands.

Cultivated cropland—This group includes land from which crops were harvested, land on which crops failed, and land under cultivation whether harvested or not, except land in cultivated and improved pasture. It includes land in sugarcane, pineapple, coffee, fruits, coconuts, etc., even though no crop was harvested; and idle cropland and cropland not harvested because of crop failure.

Land used for intercropping or successive cropping was recorded only once.

Land in pastures—This group includes cultivated and/or improved pastures, natural pastures, and pastures overgrown with brush.

Other lands—This group includes woodland, forests, and underbrush that cannot be utilized for cultivation or pastures; and land occupied by lakes, buildings, roads, fences, wasteland, trails, ponds, etc.

Land irrigated—This item represents land to which water was applied by artificial means for agricultural purposes. It includes both land under cultivation and pastureland. Separate figures were obtained for areas irrigated by water from public systems and from private systems. Some land was irrigated by water from systems or facilities operated by a public system of the Government and by water from one or more private systems. Such land was reported under both private and public systems.

For each of the above systems, data were collected on the method of applying the water such as ditches, sprinklers, or drip. Data were also obtained on the major sources of water used for irrigation such as wells or cisterns, rivers or streams, lakes or ponds, constructed reservoirs and other sources.

Off-farm work by operators—Information was obtained on the number of days the operator or senior partner worked at least four hours per day off of the place during the period from July 1, 1977, to June 30, 1978. Off-farm work included work at nonfarm jobs, businesses, or on someone else’s farm. Exchange work was excluded.

Machinery, equipment, buildings, and facilities—Data were collected on the number of various types of machinery, equipment, buildings, and facilities on the place July 1, 1978. Machinery and equipment were to be reported only if it was in working order at the time of enumeration. In addition to the number of different pieces of equipment and machinery on the place, data were collected on the estimated market value of all machinery and equipment usually kept on the place.

Hired workers, agregados, and sharecroppers—This item refers to the number of hired workers employed on the farm during the census year and to the number of agregado and sharecropper families living on the place July 1, 1978. Data were also

obtained on labor cost. Employees of labor contractors and contract labor were excluded.

An *agregado* is a member of a family which lives on a farm not operated by any member of the family. An *agregado* may or may not be an employee of the farm operator and they may or may not produce any agricultural products. They may own, rent, or use rent free, the house in which they live. The land operated by, livestock belonging to, and the products marketed by an *agregado* family were to be included with those of the farm operator in charge of the place.

A *sharecropper* (*medianero*) is a person who works land under a definite arrangement with a farm operator, receiving a part of the crops, livestock, or livestock products in return for their labor and other contributions. Since it is possible for the same person to work as a sharecropper on more than one farm, census figures may overstate their number. Likewise, a person might live as an *agregado* on one farm and work as a sharecropper on another and therefore be counted as both. Land, crops, and livestock involved in such share arrangements were to be included with those of the farm operator in charge of the place.

Agricultural chemicals—This item includes the usage and costs of agricultural chemicals used on the farm during the census year; costs of application was excluded. Application costs were to be included with expenses for machine hire and customwork.

Production expenses—Data on farm production expenses were obtained for:

- a. Livestock and poultry.
- b. Feed for livestock and poultry.
- c. Medicines and drugs for livestock and poultry.
- d. Seeds, bulbs, plants, and trees.
- e. Commercial fertilizers.
- f. Gasoline and other fuel and oil products for the farm business.
- g. Wages and salaries paid to employees or hired farm workers.
- h. Contract labor.
- i. Machine hire and customwork.
- j. Agricultural chemicals.

Expenses were to be reported for the period from July 1, 1977, to June 30, 1978. The information was to include all expenses incurred by the farm operator, landlords, sharecroppers, *agregados*, contractors, buyers and others from crops, livestock, or livestock products produced on the place. Wages and salaries paid to employees or hired farm workers were to be included. Wages and salaries paid to domestic help or contract labor were to be excluded, also expenses relating to the family home and automobile.

Crops—The names of the principal crops were preprinted on the report form and space was provided to write in other crops. Data were collected for each crop harvested from the place

during the period from July 1, 1977, to June 30, 1978, regardless of who did the harvesting.

Data collected were:

Sugarcane—Cuerdas harvested and amount harvested.

Coffee, tobacco, pineapple, grains, and farinaceous crops—Cuerdas harvested and amount harvested and sold.

Vegetables harvested for sale—Cuerdas and value of sales.

Ornamental and flowering plants and lawn grass—Area used and value of sales.

Fruit trees and plants—Number of trees of bearing age and trees not of bearing age and amount harvested and sold.

Livestock and poultry—Data were obtained for the number of livestock and poultry on the farms as of July 1, 1978, regardless of ownership. It also included other livestock and poultry kept on the place for others or grown under a contract. Sales of livestock, poultry, and livestock and poultry products relate to the period from July 1, 1977, to June 30, 1978.

Value of agricultural products sold—This item represents the gross market value before taxes and production expenses of all agricultural products sold or removed from the place from July 1, 1977, to June 30, 1978, regardless of who received the payment. It includes receipts by the operator as well as the value of any shares received by partners, landlords, *agregados*, sharecroppers, contractors and others associated with the place.

The total value of agricultural products represents the sum of all crops sold from the place including ornamental and flowering plants, lawn grass, and poultry, livestock, and their products. It does not include income from farm-related sources such as agricultural services, government farm programs, recreation and other related sources, or income from nonfarm sources.

FARM CLASSIFICATION

Farms by tenure of operator—The classification of tenure is—

- a. Full owners operate only the land they own or land operated by sharecroppers and *agregados*.
- b. Part owners operate land they own and also land they rent from others.
- c. Managers operate farms for others and are paid a wage or salary for their services. Persons acting merely as caretakers, "mayordomos" (foremen), or hired laborers are not classified as managers. If a farm operator manages land for others and also operates land on his own account, the land operated on his own account is considered as one farm and the land managed for others as another farm.
- d. Tenants operate only the land they rent from others.

Farms by type of organization—Enumerators classified the farms on the basis of the operator's description of the organizational status of their farms. The major classifications are:

- a. Individual or family farm.
- b. Partnership.
- c. Corporation.
- d. Other, such as estate or cooperative.

Individual or family farms are further defined as private, Title IV, Title V, and Title VI. Corporation farms are further defined as family corporations of less than 10 persons, private corporations of 10 persons or more, and government corporations or agencies.

Farms by age and main occupation of operator—Age of the farm operator, as of the last birthday, and occupation of the farm operator were obtained for all farms. The operators were classified into one of the following age groups:

- a. Under 25 years.
- b. 25 to 34 years.
- c. 35 to 44 years.
- d. 45 to 54 years.
- e. 55 to 64 years.
- f. 65 years and over.

Each of these age groups were further classified as to whether the main occupation of the farm operator was agricultural or nonagricultural.

Farms by size—All farms were classified by size according to the total land area of each farm:

- a. Less than 3 cuerdas.
- b. 3 to 9 cuerdas.
- c. 10 to 19 cuerdas.
- d. 20 to 49 cuerdas.
- e. 50 to 99 cuerdas.
- f. 100 to 174 cuerdas.
- g. 175 to 259 cuerdas.
- h. 260 to 499 cuerdas.
- i. 500 to 749 cuerdas.
- j. 750 to 999 cuerdas.
- k. 1,000 cuerdas or more.

Farms by value of agricultural products sold—All farms were classified by value of agricultural products sold. Farms with values of less than \$150 were further classified according to the number of days the operator worked off the farm. Farms operated by institutions or government agencies were also included in this classification. Income from farm-related sources such as agricultural services, recreational services, land rent and payments from government farm programs were excluded from the basis for this classification.

The first ten groups are on the basis of value of farm products sold; the last two groups are on the basis of the value of products sold and days worked off farm:

1. \$60,000 or more sales.
2. \$40,000 to \$59,999 sales.
3. \$20,000 to \$39,999 sales.
4. \$10,000 to \$19,999 sales.
5. \$7,500 to \$9,999 sales.
6. \$5,000 to \$7,499 sales.
7. \$2,500 to \$4,999 sales.
8. \$1,200 to \$2,499 sales.
9. \$500 to \$1,199 sales.
10. \$150 to \$499 sales.

11. Less than \$150 sales with 75 days or more of work off farm.
12. Less than \$150 sales with less than 75 days of work off farm.

Farms by type—Type of farm represents a description of the major source of income from the sale of agricultural products. To be classified as a particular type of farm, the farm had to have sales of a specific product or group of products amounting in value of 50 percent or more of the total value of all products sold during the census reference period.

The types of farms, together with the products (value of sales representing 50 percent or more of the value of agricultural products sold during the year) on which the type of classification is based, are:

Sugarcane	Sugarcane.
Coffee	Coffee.
Tobacco	Tobacco.
Grains and farinaceous crops	Corn, pigeon peas, dry beans, taniers, dashesens, cassava, celeriac, yams, sweetpotatoes, and other minor field crops.
Fruits and nuts	All tree fruits, nuts, bananas, plantains, and pineapples.
Livestock	Livestock, poultry, and livestock and poultry products.
General crop	All crops included in the sugarcane, coffee, tobacco, grain and farinaceous crops, and fruit and nut types, but not including vegetables or ornamental and flowering plants and lawn grass.
Crop and livestock	Crops as listed in the general-crop type together with the livestock, poultry, and livestock and poultry products in the livestock type.
Miscellaneous	All farms not meeting any of the above classifications. These include farms with 50 percent or more of the total value of agricultural products sold coming from the sale of vegetables or ornamental and flowering plants and lawn grass.

Other classifications—Farms were also classified by the characteristics of the operator, such as his residence, principal source of income, years operating the farm, education, days worked off farm, and by the percent of his income received from farming.

ENUMERATION PERIODS

All tables have a headnote, "See Text, Explanation of Enumeration Periods." The enumeration periods for the 1978 census were either the 12-month period from July 1, 1977, to June 30, 1978, or as of July 1, 1978. Whenever 1974 is used in a table, title or boxhead, it refers to the census period July 1,

1974, to June 30, 1975. Whenever 1975 is used, it refers to July 1, 1975.

Data for the following items relate to the 12-month period from July 1, 1977, to June 30, 1978, or to the period of July 1, 1974, to June 30, 1975, when applicable:

- a. Tenure.
- b. Land in farms.
- c. Agricultural products harvested and products sold.
- d. Livestock, poultry, and their products sold.
- e. Cultivated and/or improved pasture.
- f. Land use.
- g. Irrigation.
- h. Hired workers.

- i. Agricultural chemicals purchased and used.
- j. Farm production expenses.
- k. Farm related income.
- l. Products for home consumption.

Data for the following items pertain to July 1, 1978, or July 1, 1975, when applicable:

- a. Inventory of livestock, hogs, and poultry on farms.
- b. Machinery, equipment, buildings, and facilities on farms.
- c. Number of agregado and sharecropper families on farms.
- d. Sugarcane, coffee, pineapple, rice, and all fruits under cultivation.
