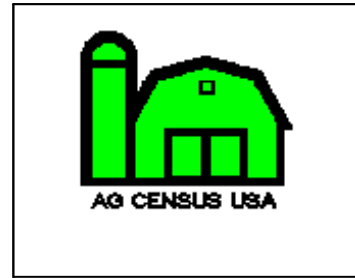


# 1997 Census of Agriculture County Profile

## DREW ARKANSAS

### Land in farms

Increased 11 percent from 110,260 acres in 1992 to 122,552 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Increased slightly from 357 acres in 1992 to 358 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Increased 4 percent from 169 farms in 1992 to 175 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

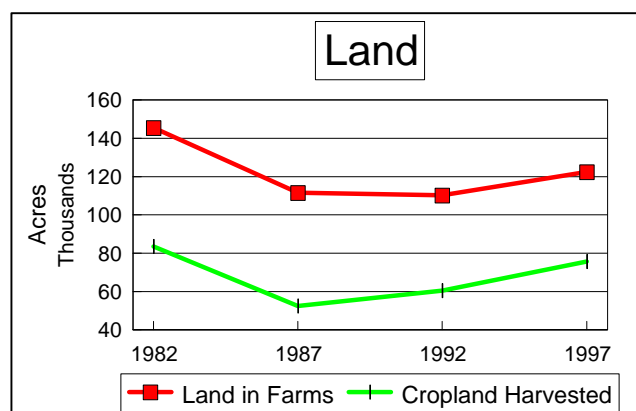
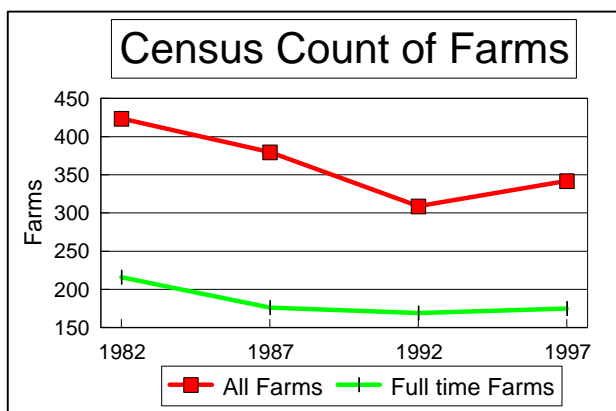
Increased 72 percent to \$35,809,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 78 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 22 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 55 percent from \$67,337 in 1992 to \$104,704 in 1997.
