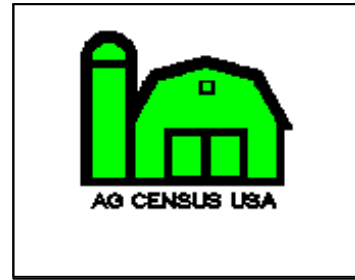


# 1997 Census of Agriculture County Profile

## LOGAN ARKANSAS

### Land in farms

Increased 7 percent from 186,829 acres in 1992 to 199,294 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Increased 5 percent from 199 acres in 1992 to 209 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 8 percent from 437 farms in 1992 to 400 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

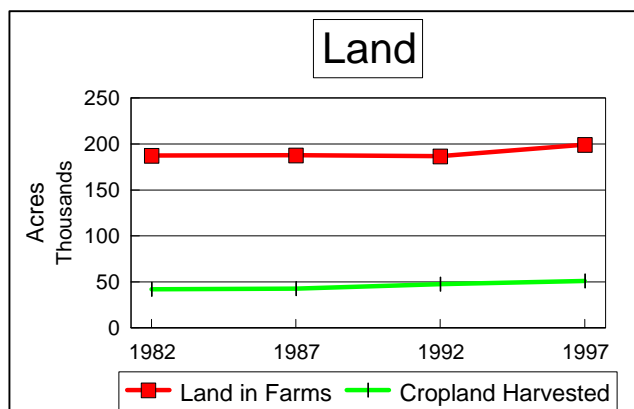
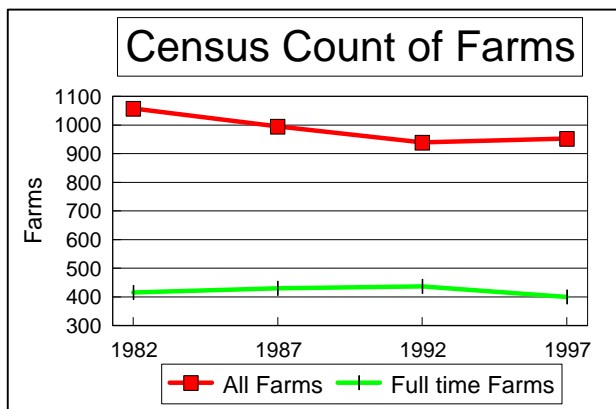
Increased 62 percent to \$92,617,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 3 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 97 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 60 percent from \$60,883 in 1992 to \$97,184 in 1997.
