

Increased 4 percent from 160 acres in 1992 to 167 acres in 1997.

Decreased slightly from 173 farms in 1992 to 172 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold


Increased 23 percent to \$228,881,000 in 1997.


Crop sales accounted for 99 percent of the market value.
