Market value of agricultural products sold

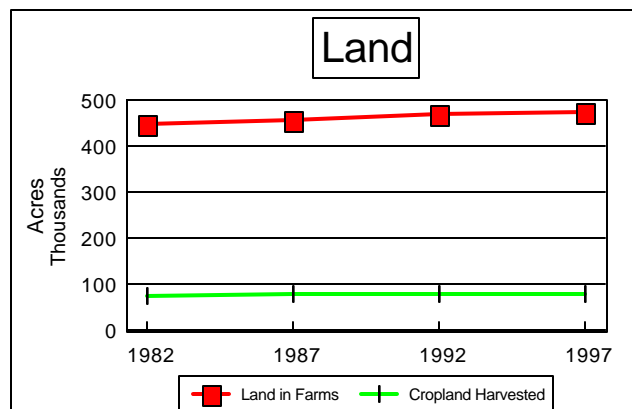
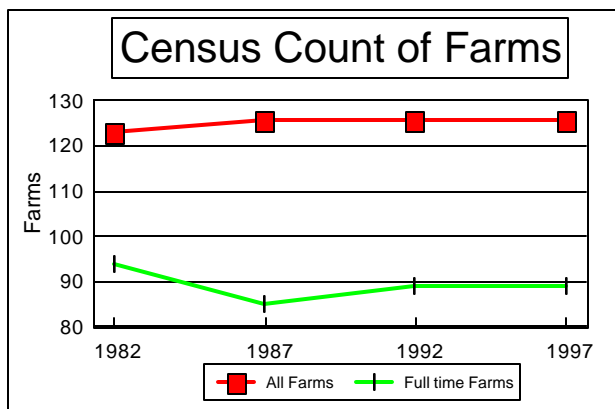
Decreased 16 percent to \$15,593,000 in 1997.
