## LOGAN COLORADO

### Land in farms

Increased 6 percent from 1,066,453 acres in 1992 to 1,128,756 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Increased 8 percent from 1,189 acres in 1992 to 1,284 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 6 percent from 629 farms in 1992 to 594 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

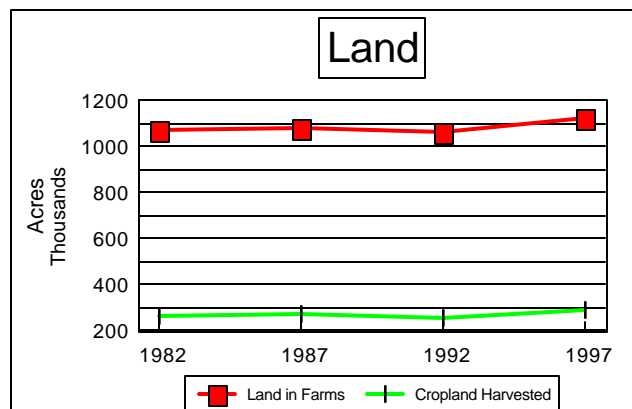
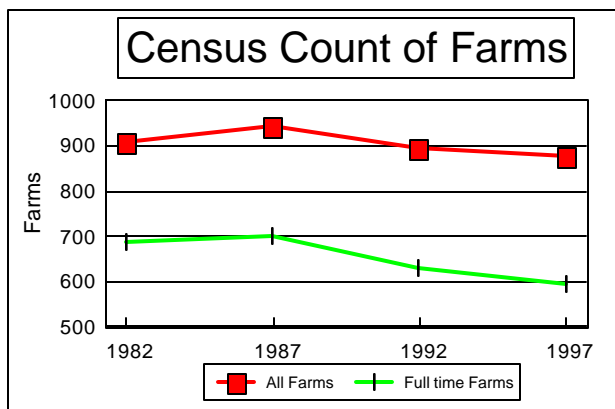
Increased 8 percent to \$292,740,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 17 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 83 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 10 percent from \$302,726 in 1992 to \$333,038 in 1997.
