

Increased 3 percent from 1,262 acres in 1992 to 1,303 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 2 percent from 339 farms in 1992 to 333 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold


Increased 48 percent to \$21,874,000 in 1997.


Crop sales accounted for 59 percent of the market value.
