## OSCEOLA FLORIDA

### Land in farms

Decreased 15 percent from 716,542 acres in 1992 to 610,825 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Decreased 12 percent from 1,436 acres in 1992 to 1,259 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased slightly from 240 farms in 1992 to 239 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold



Increased 67 percent to \$88,784,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 68 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 32 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 72 percent from \$106,607 in 1992 to \$183,061 in 1997.
