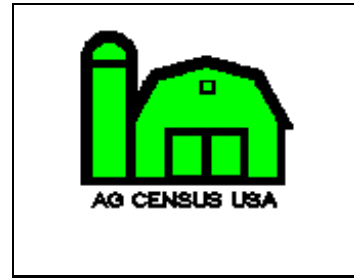

Land in farms

Decreased 5 percent from 121,588 acres in 1992 to 116,040 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Increased 9 percent from 422 acres in 1992 to 462 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 7 percent from 174 farms in 1992 to 161 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

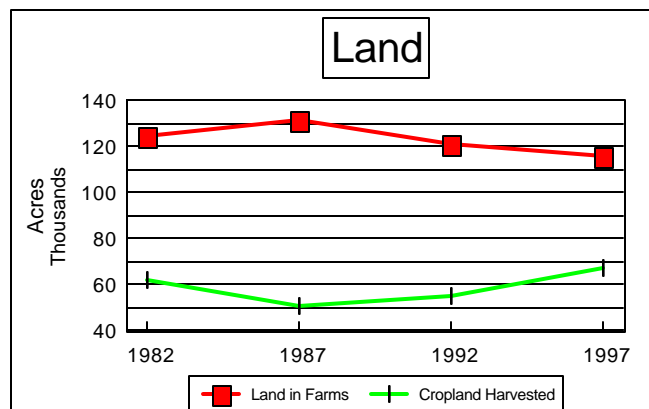
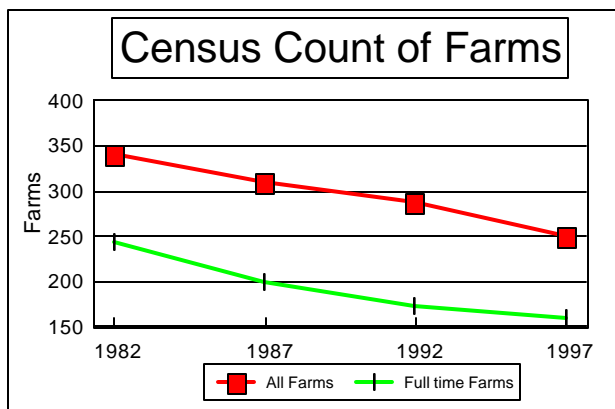
Increased 16 percent to \$38,183,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 82 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 18 percent of the market value.
