Market value of agricultural products sold

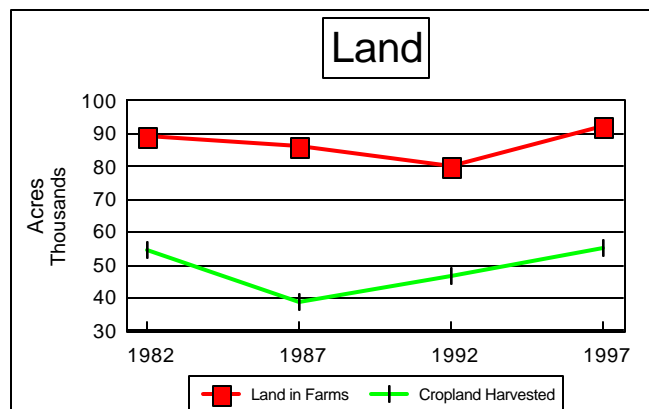
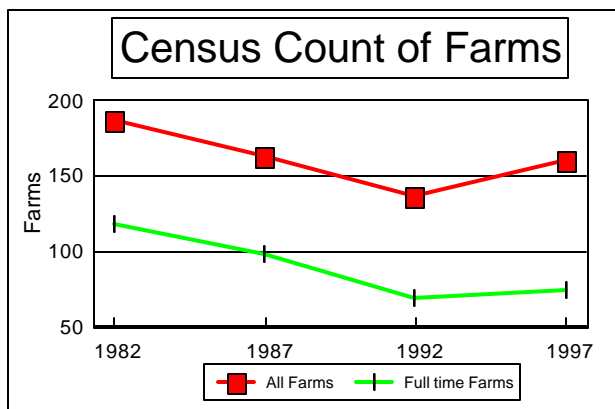
Increased 28 percent to \$27,627,000 in 1997.
