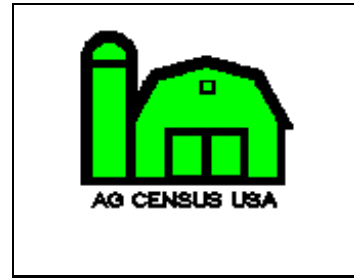

Decreased 1 percent from 108,967 acres in 1992 to 107,372 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased slightly from 592 acres in 1992 to 587 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 3 percent from 97 farms in 1992 to 100 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

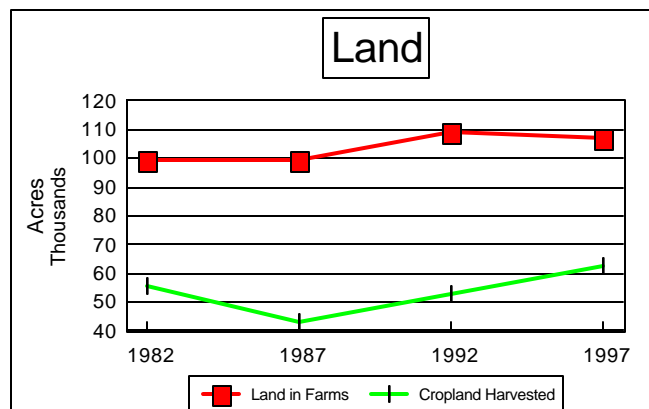
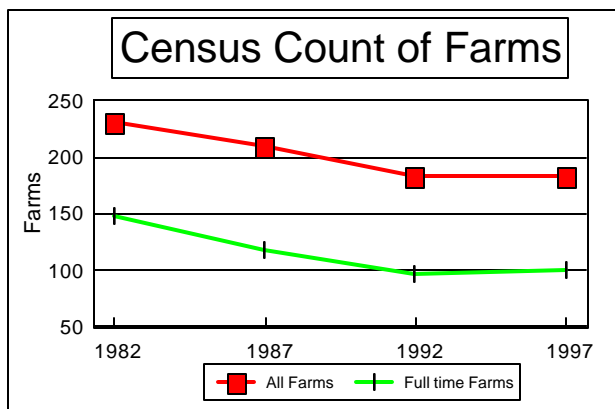
Increased 32 percent to \$39,861,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 92 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 8 percent of the market value.
