## TREUTLEN GEORGIA

### Land in farms

Increased 28 percent from 32,800 acres in 1992 to 42,027 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Decreased 5 percent from 283 acres in 1992 to 268 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 4 percent from 48 farms in 1992 to 46 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

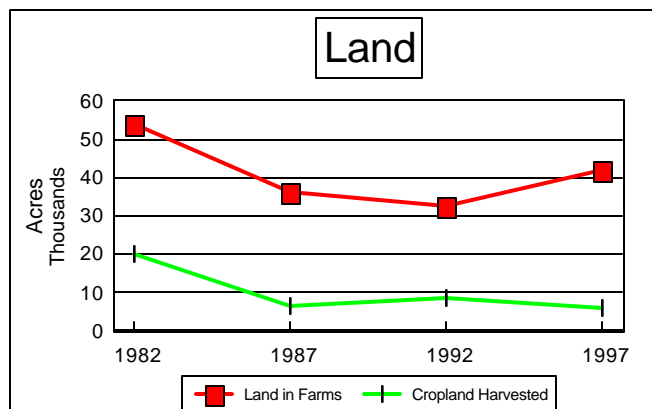
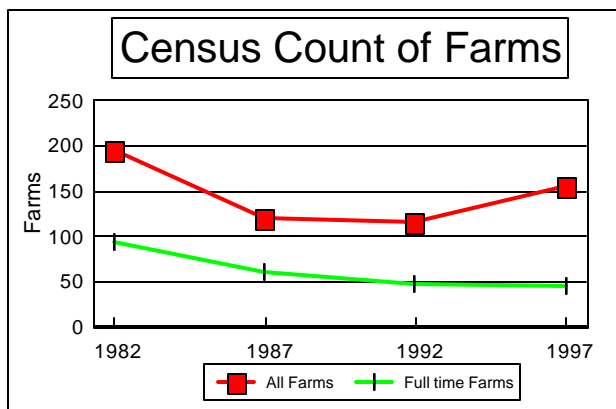
Decreased 35 percent to \$2,900,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 89 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 11 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Decreased 52 percent from \$38,730 in 1992 to \$18,474 in 1997.
