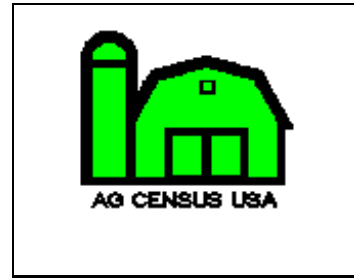


# 1997 Census of Agriculture County Profile

## WARREN GEORGIA

### Land in farms

Decreased 5 percent from 47,000 acres in 1992 to 44,447 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Decreased 4 percent from 346 acres in 1992 to 332 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Increased 5 percent from 59 farms in 1992 to 62 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

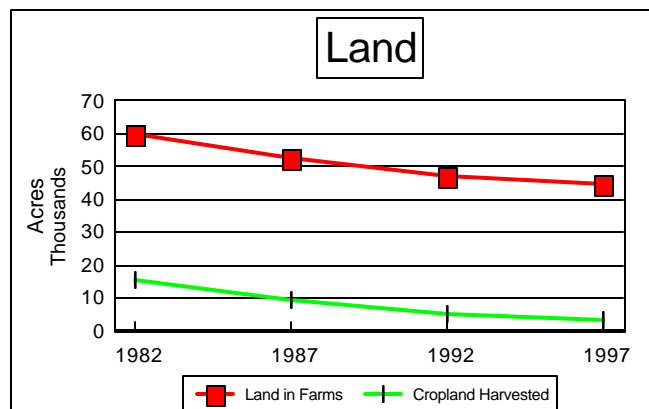
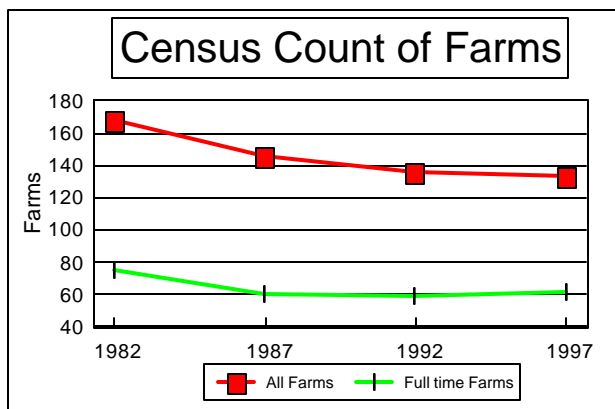
Decreased 13 percent to \$4,394,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 10 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 90 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Decreased 12 percent from \$37,193 in 1992 to \$32,791 in 1997.
