Decreased 9 percent from 236 acres in 1992 to 215 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 17 percent from 12 farms in 1992 to 14 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

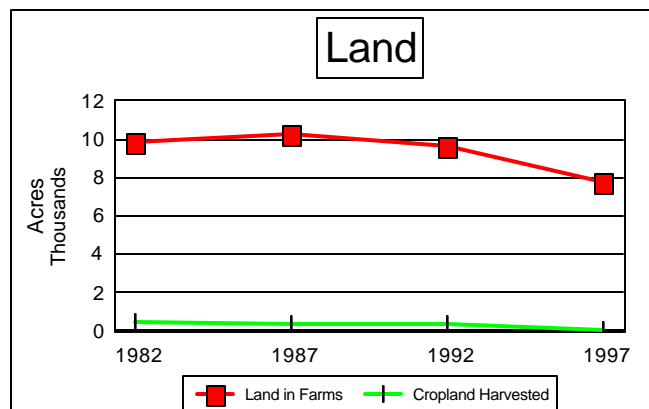
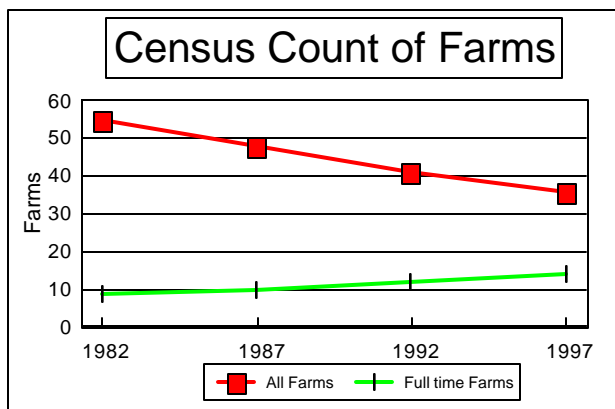
Increased 45 percent to \$375,000 in 1997.
