Decreased 2 percent from 585 acres in 1992 to 571 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 2 percent from 412 farms in 1992 to 402 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

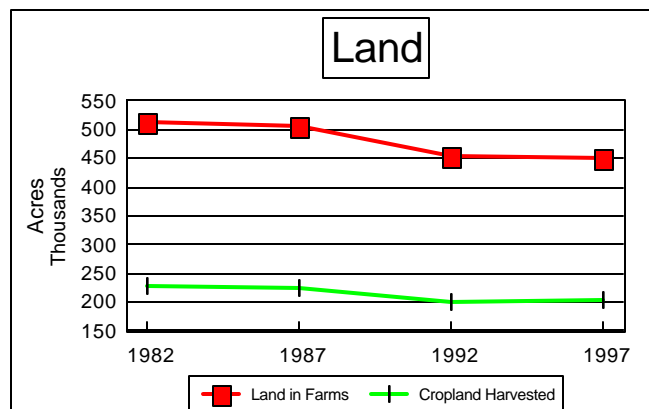
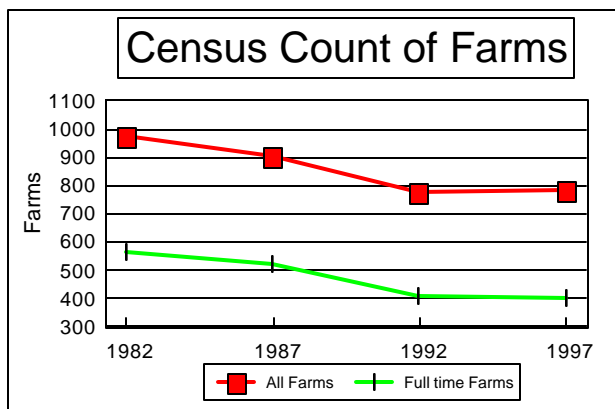
Decreased 11 percent to \$90,589,000 in 1997.
