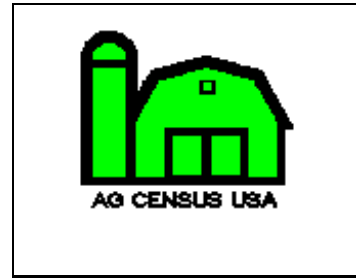

Land in farms

Decreased 2 percent from 129,490 acres in 1992 to 127,514 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 7 percent from 1,392 acres in 1992 to 1,301 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 10 percent from 63 farms in 1992 to 69 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

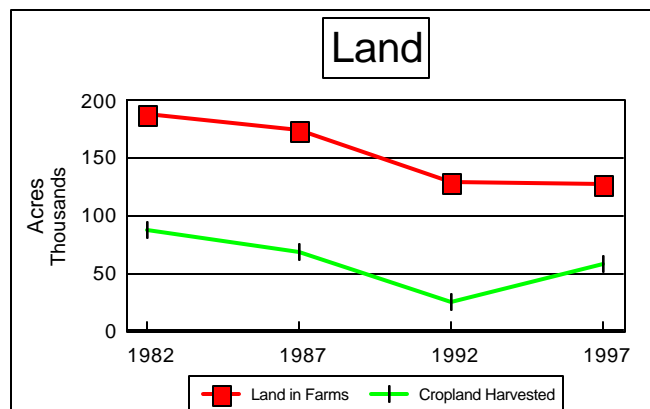
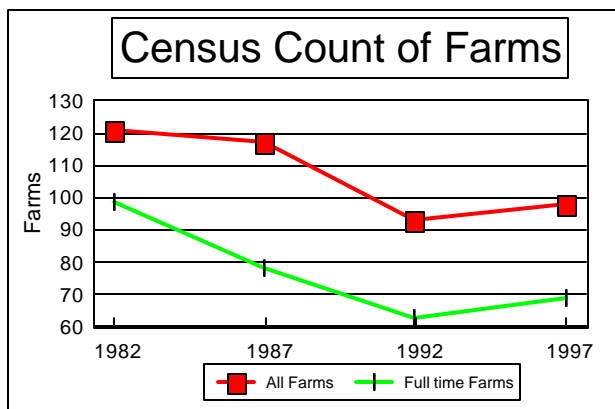
Increased 106 percent to \$8,815,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 77 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 23 percent of the market value.
