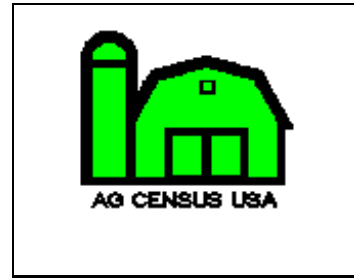

Decreased 11 percent from 209 acres in 1992 to 187 acres in 1997.

Decreased 9 percent from 1,066 farms in 1992 to 969 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

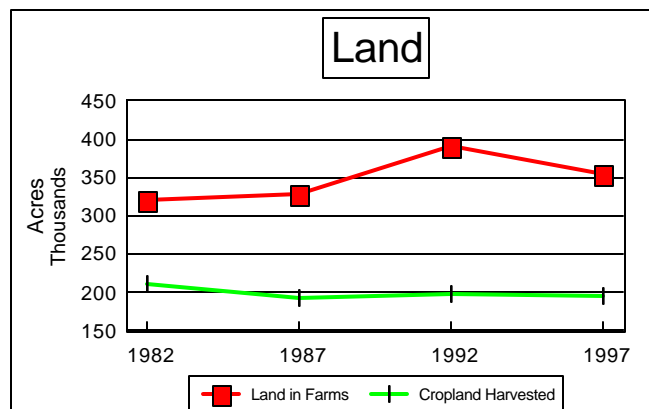
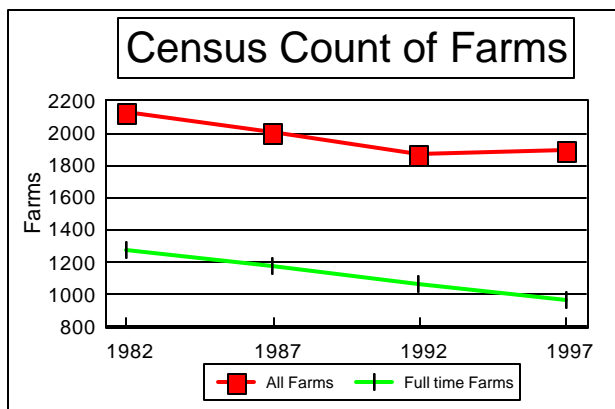
Increased 19 percent to \$311,397,000 in 1997.
