Market value of agricultural products sold

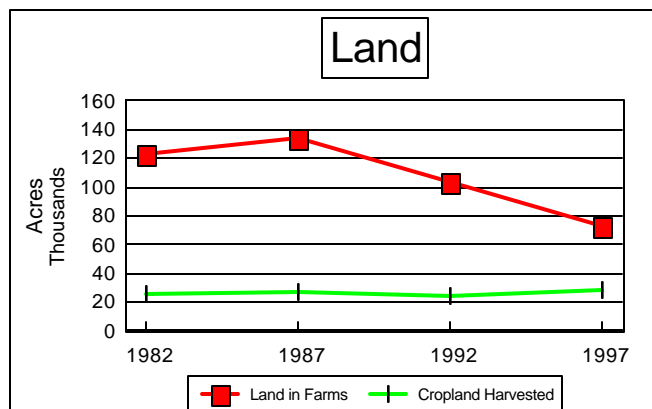
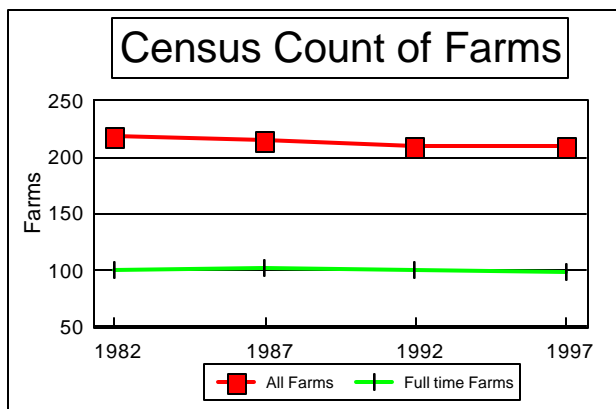
Increased 5 percent to \$4,849,000 in 1997.
