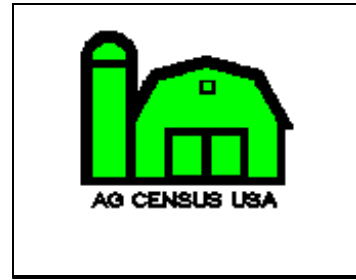

Land in farms

Decreased slightly from 131,281 acres in 1992 to 130,843 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 10 percent from 243 acres in 1992 to 219 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 18 percent from 235 farms in 1992 to 277 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

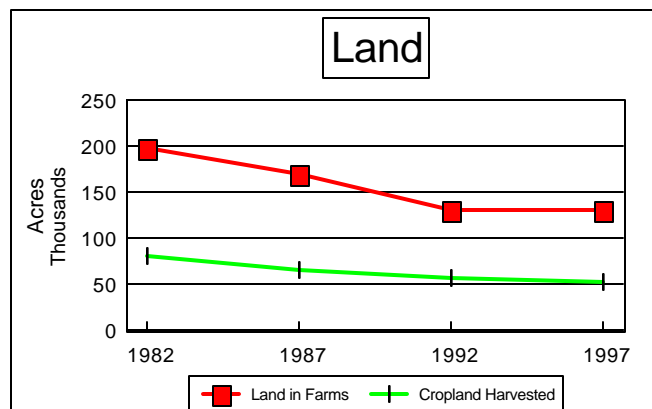
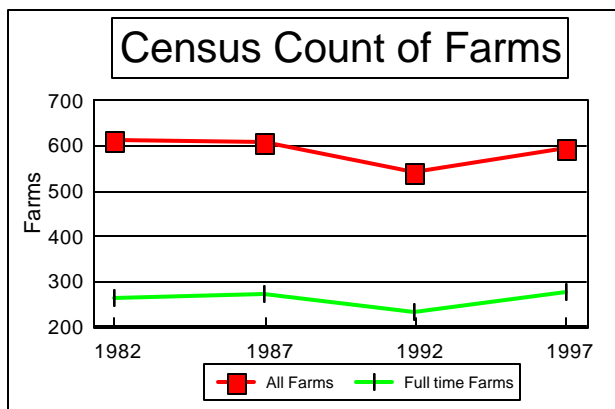
Decreased 20 percent to \$13,581,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 81 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 19 percent of the market value.

Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Decreased 28 percent from \$31,492 in 1992 to \$22,711 in 1997.
