Decreased 16 percent from 553 acres in 1992 to 466 acres in 1997.

Increased 11 percent from 242 farms in 1992 to 269 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

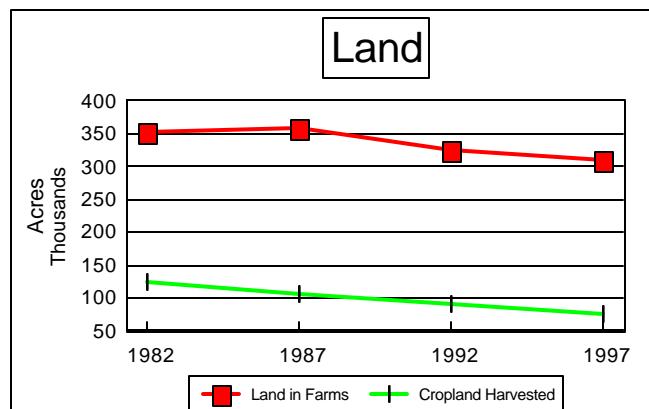
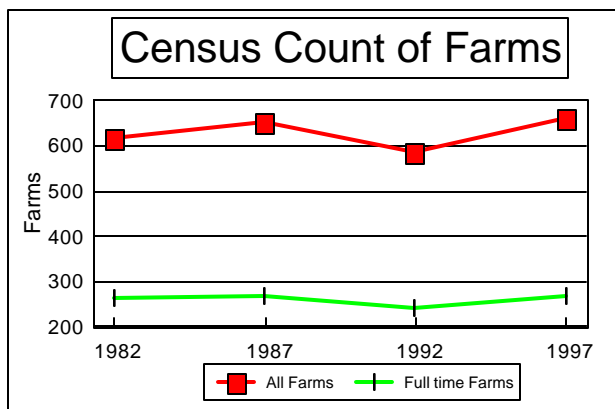
Decreased 3 percent to \$25,032,000 in 1997.
