Decreased 17 percent from 143 farms in 1992 to 118 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

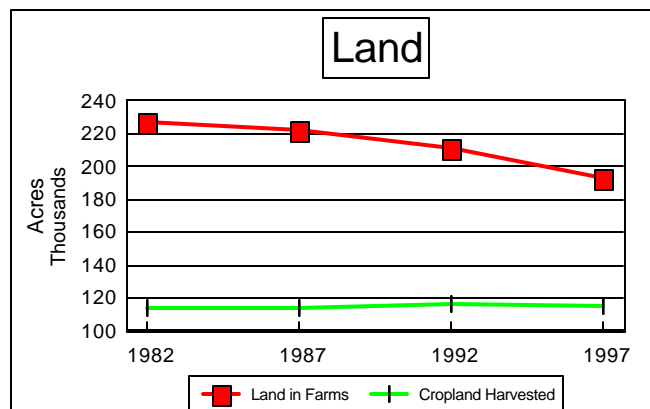
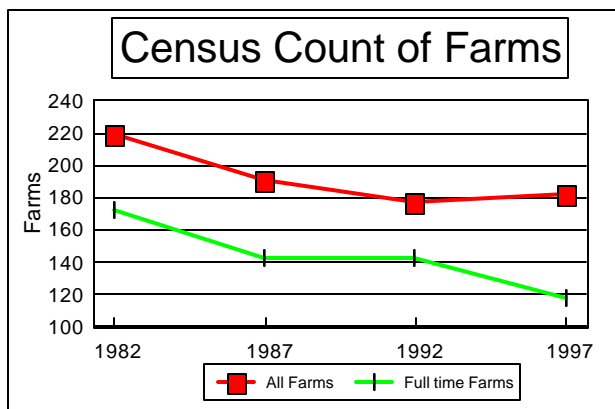
Increased 3 percent to \$20,157,000 in 1997.
