Market value of agricultural products sold

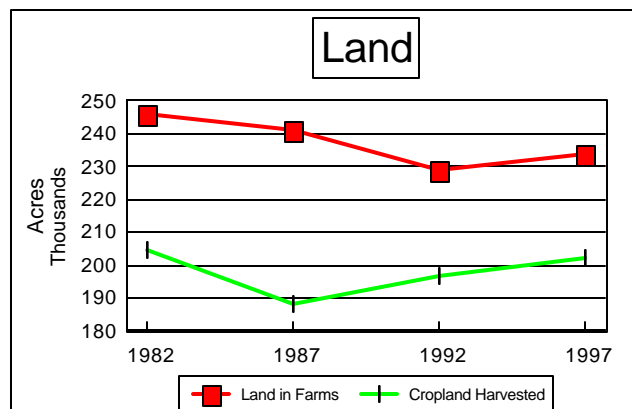
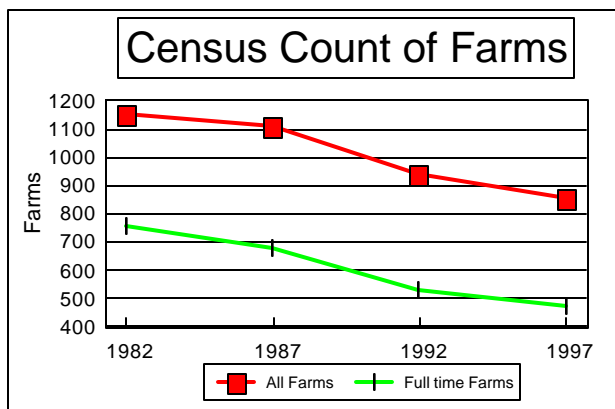
Increased 12 percent to \$106,672,000 in 1997.
