Market value of agricultural products sold

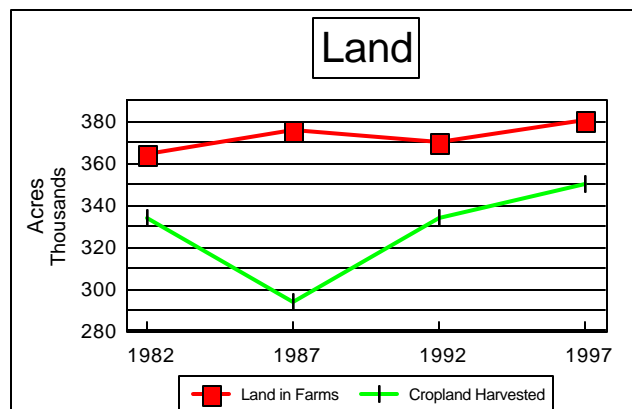
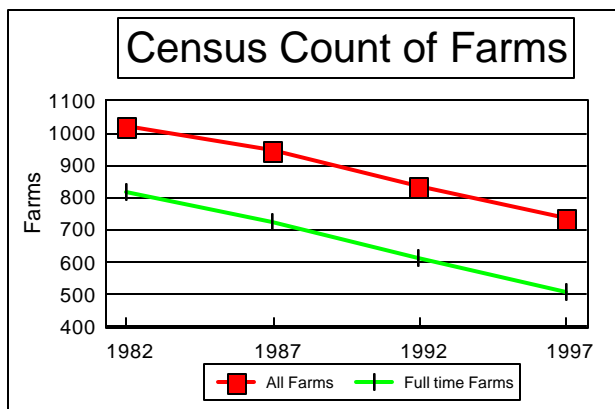
Increased 21 percent to \$133,249,000 in 1997.
