Decreased 16 percent from 575 farms in 1992 to 481 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

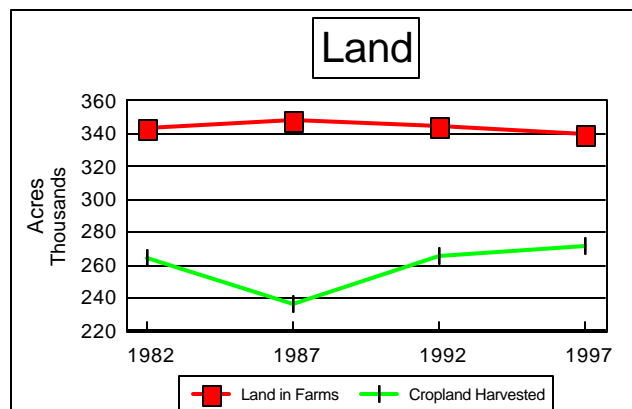
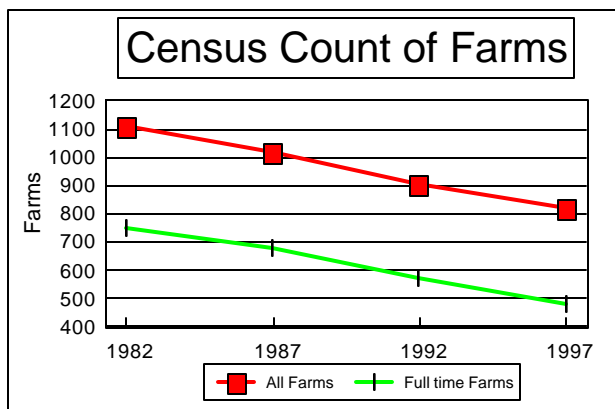
Increased 12 percent to \$96,818,000 in 1997.
