Market value of agricultural products sold

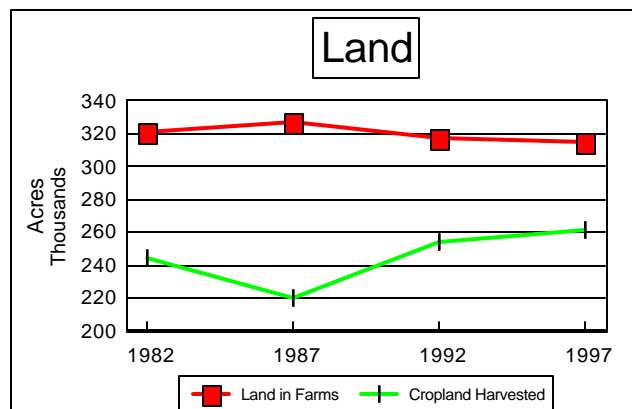
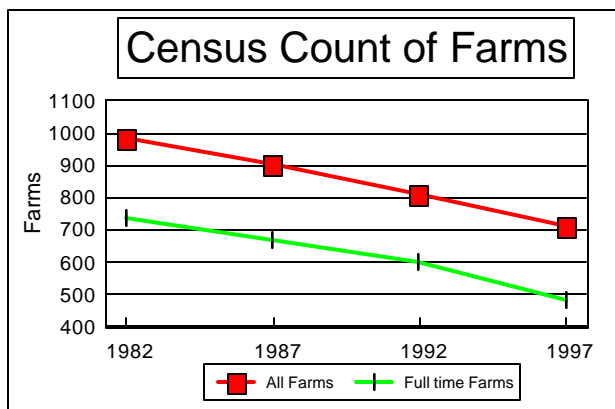
Increased 13 percent to \$105,083,000 in 1997.
