Increased 4 percent from 238 acres in 1992 to 248 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 6 percent from 427 farms in 1992 to 400 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

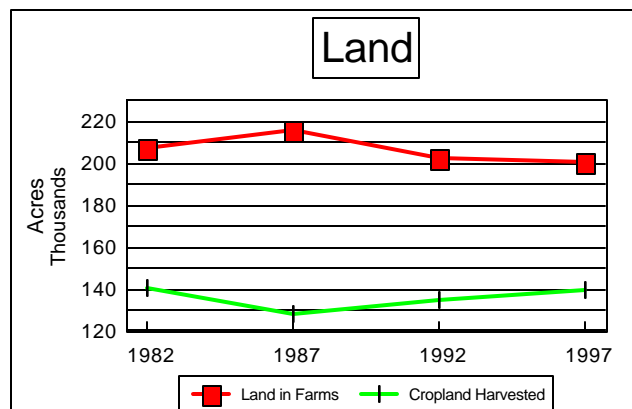
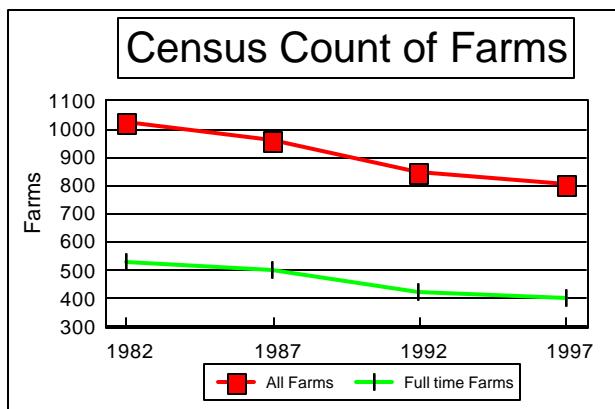
Increased 26 percent to \$92,711,000 in 1997.
