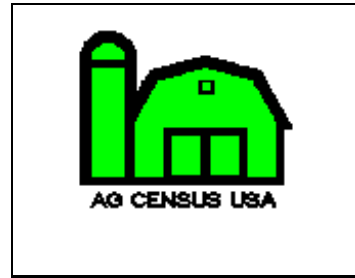

Land in farms

Decreased 3 percent from 242,777 acres in 1992 to 236,332 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Increased 16 percent from 385 acres in 1992 to 445 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 14 percent from 390 farms in 1992 to 335 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

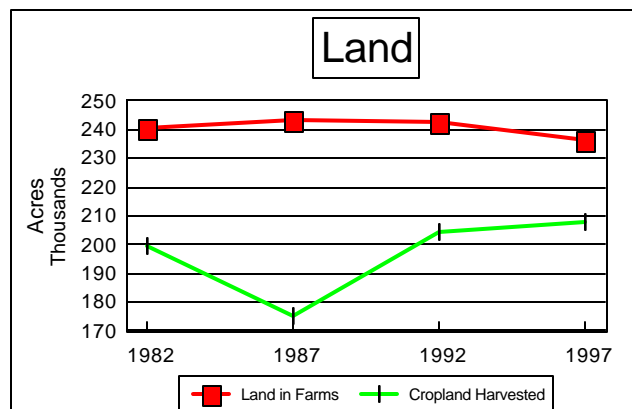
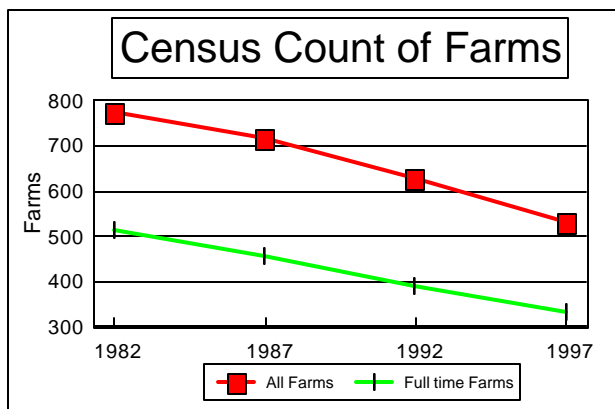
Increased 30 percent to \$98,057,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 62 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 38 percent of the market value.
