Increased 1 percent from 201 farms in 1992 to 204 farms in 1997.

Increased 17 percent to \$33,138,000 in 1997.
Crop sales accounted for 96 percent of the market value.
Livestock sales accounted for 4 percent of the market value.

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Increased 10 percent from \$73,181 in 1992 to \$80,825 in 1997.
