## WARREN INDIANA

### Land in farms

Decreased 8 percent from 201,739 acres in 1992 to 184,653 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Increased 5 percent from 464 acres in 1992 to 489 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 24 percent from 271 farms in 1992 to 206 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

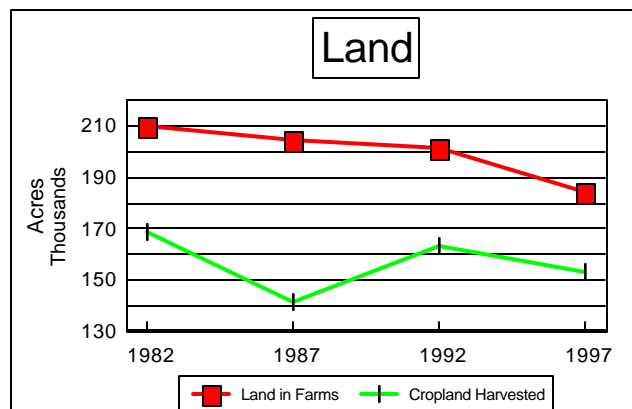
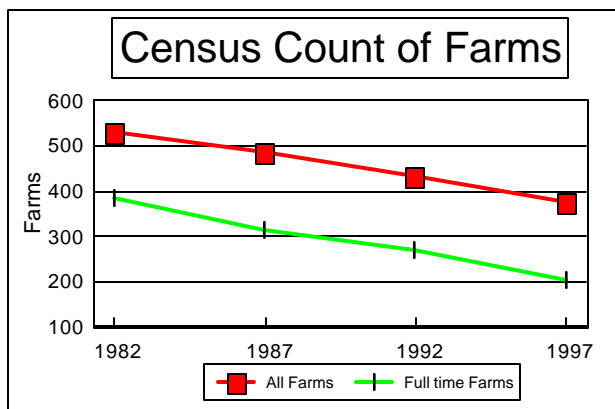
Increased 34 percent to \$57,996,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 71 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 29 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 54 percent from \$99,783 in 1992 to \$153,429 in 1997.
