Market value of agricultural products sold

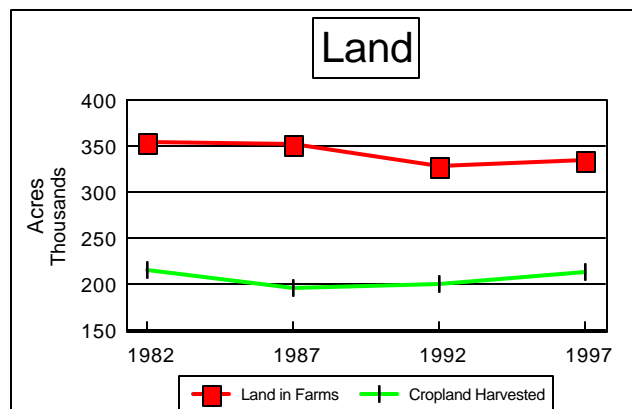
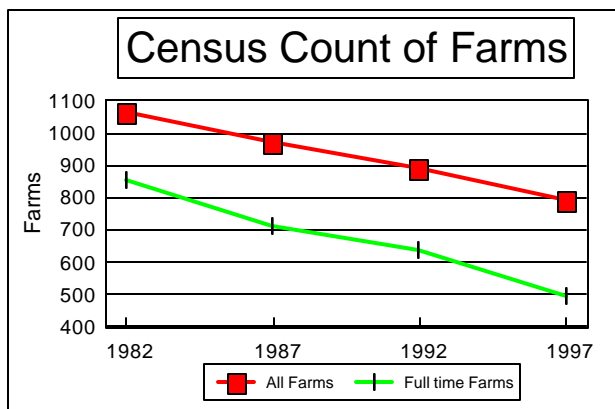
Increased 10 percent to \$82,545,000 in 1997.
