Market value of agricultural products sold

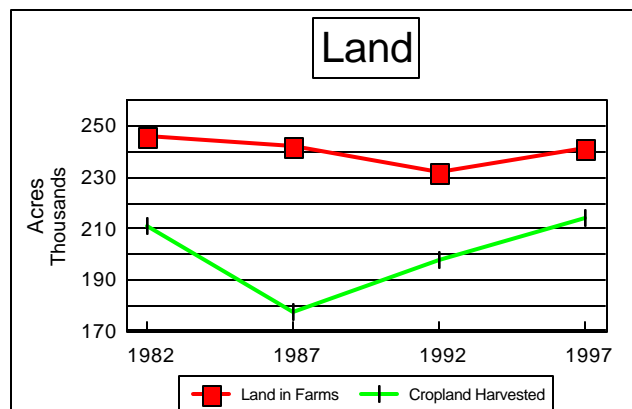
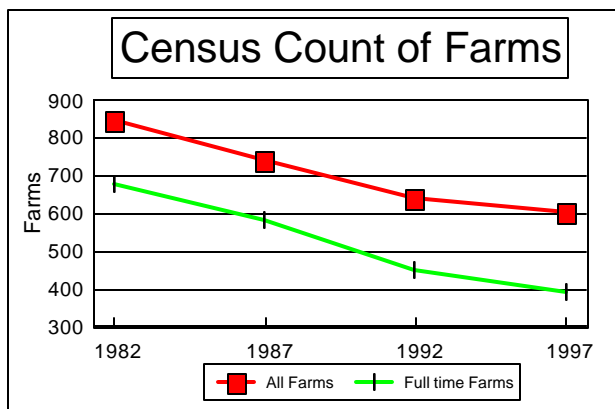
Increased 29 percent to \$78,356,000 in 1997.
