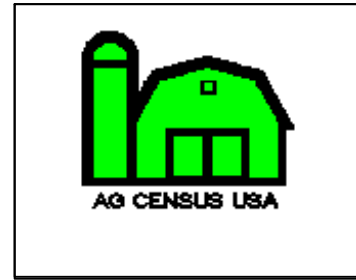


# 1997 Census of Agriculture State Profile

## KANSAS

### Land in farms

Decreased 1 percent from 46,672,188 acres in 1992 to 46,089,268 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Increased 1 percent from 738 acres in 1992 to 748 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 11 percent from 39,324 farms in 1992 to 34,979 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

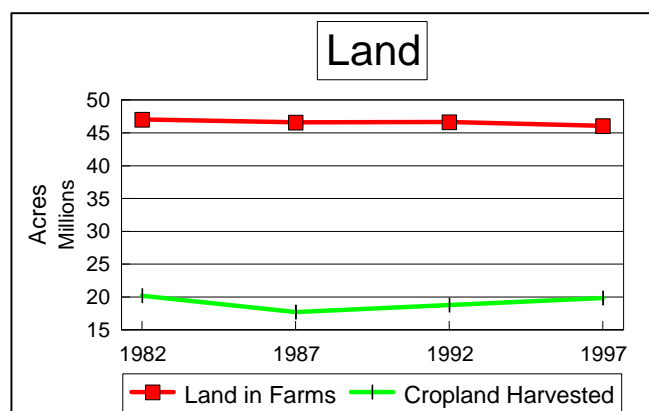
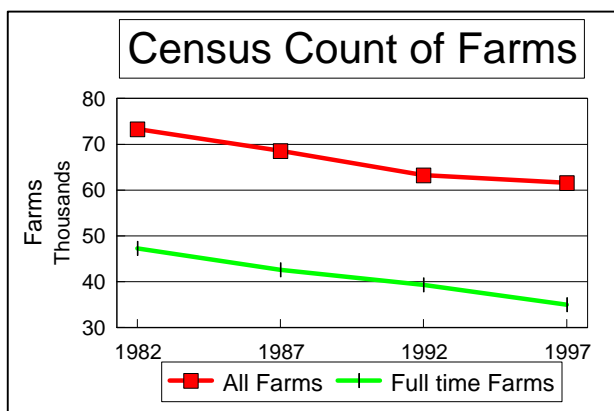
Increased 11 percent to \$9,207,130,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 35 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 65 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 14 percent from \$131,420 in 1992 to \$149,483 in 1997.
