Land in farms

Decreased slightly from 22,553 acres in 1992 to 22,351 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 11 percent from 132 acres in 1992 to 118 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 19 percent from 64 farms in 1992 to 52 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

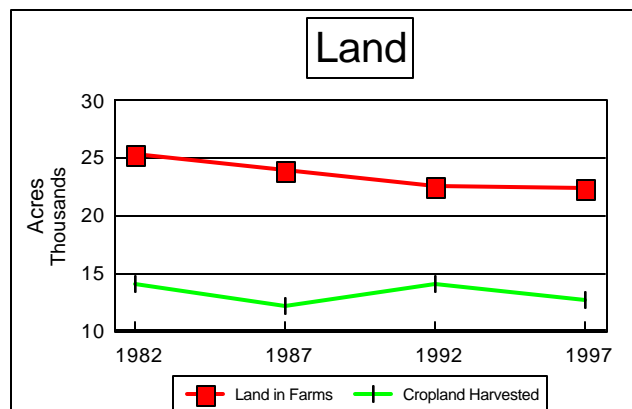
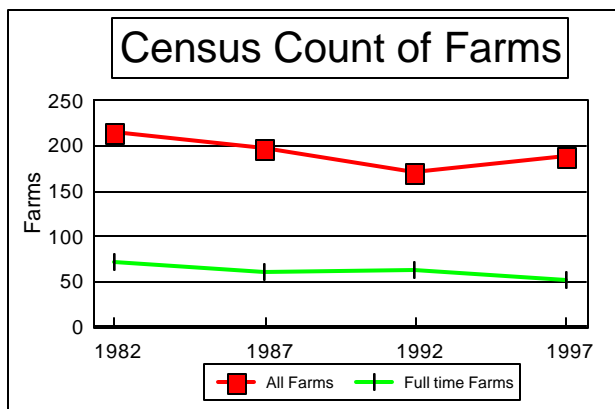
Decreased 5 percent to \$4,658,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 68 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 32 percent of the market value.
