## CHEYENNE KANSAS

### Land in farms

Decreased 5 percent from 592,207 acres in 1992 to 562,300 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Increased 2 percent from 1,390 acres in 1992 to 1,413 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 14 percent from 326 farms in 1992 to 279 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

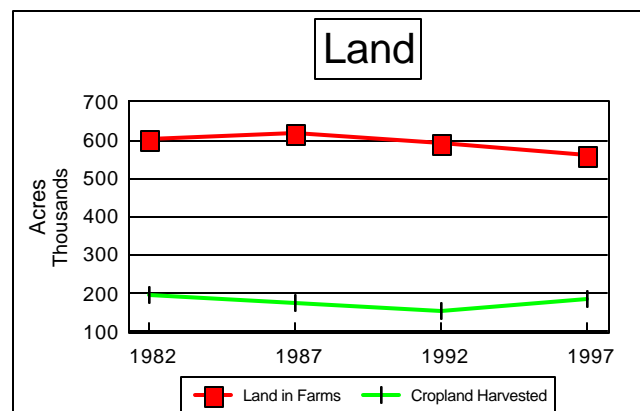
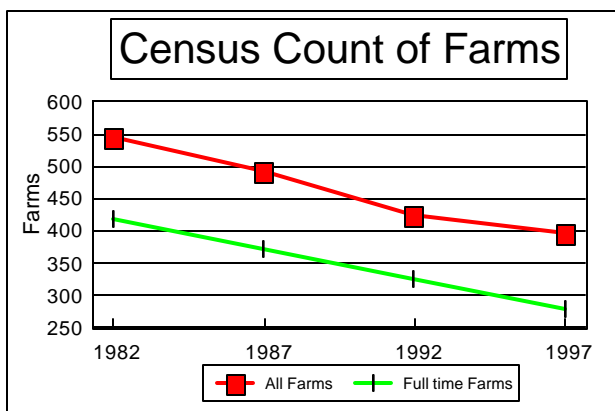
Increased 4 percent to \$53,543,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 54 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 46 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 11 percent from \$121,106 in 1992 to \$134,530 in 1997.
