Decreased 8 percent from 601 acres in 1992 to 553 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 15 percent from 353 farms in 1992 to 301 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

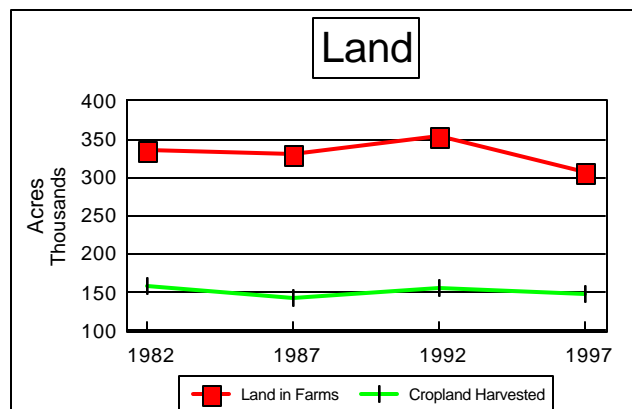
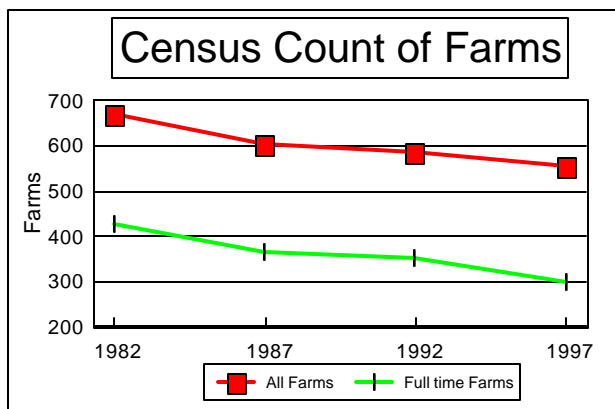
Decreased 6 percent to \$39,308,000 in 1997.
