Decreased slightly from 538 acres in 1992 to 533 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 11 percent from 433 farms in 1992 to 384 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

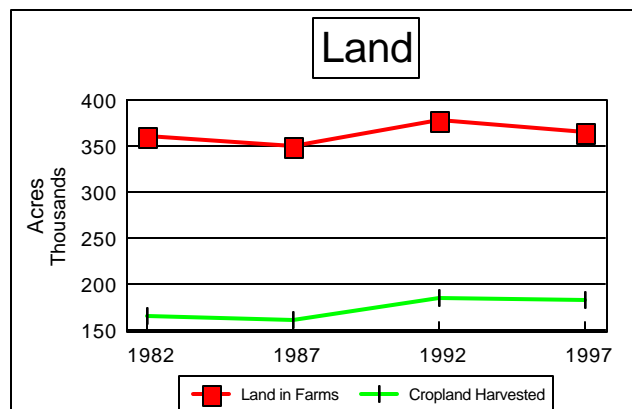
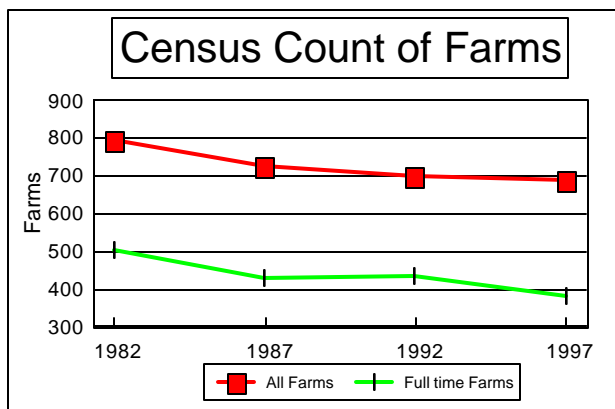
Increased 16 percent to \$53,256,000 in 1997.
