## DONIPHAN KANSAS

### Land in farms

Increased 10 percent from 201,798 acres in 1992 to 222,074 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Increased 11 percent from 396 acres in 1992 to 438 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 8 percent from 319 farms in 1992 to 293 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

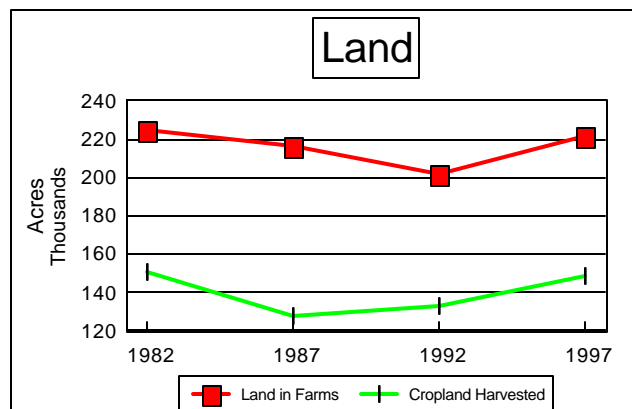
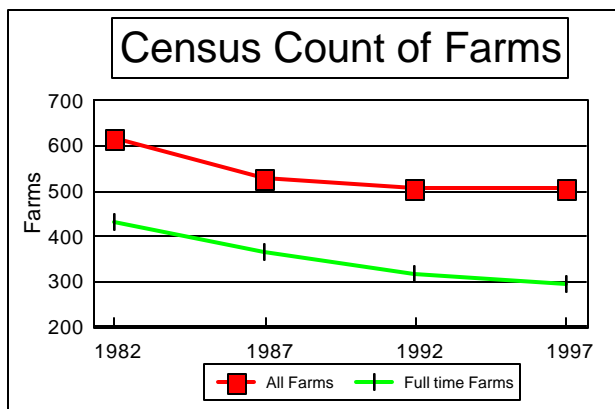
Increased 27 percent to \$47,107,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 85 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 15 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 27 percent from \$72,989 in 1992 to \$92,913 in 1997.
