## GRANT KANSAS

### Land in farms

Decreased 3 percent from 341,608 acres in 1992 to 332,607 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Decreased 2 percent from 1,319 acres in 1992 to 1,294 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 12 percent from 205 farms in 1992 to 180 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

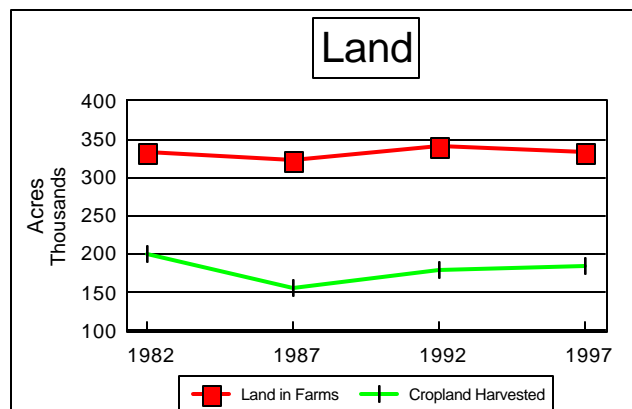
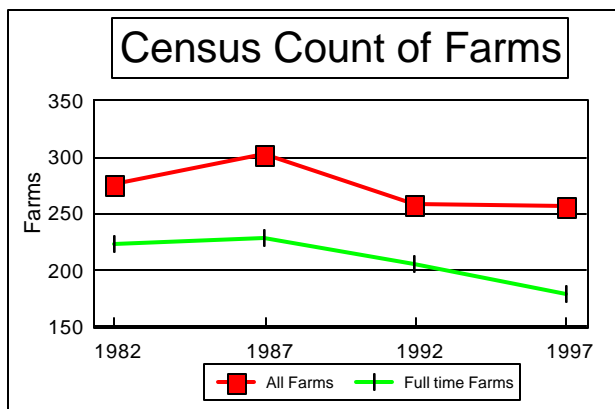
Increased slightly

Crop sales accounted for 15 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 85 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 2 percent from \$1,115,271 in 1992 to \$1,133,381 in 1997.
