Decreased 12 percent from 1,844 acres in 1992 to 1,618 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 6 percent from 172 farms in 1992 to 182 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

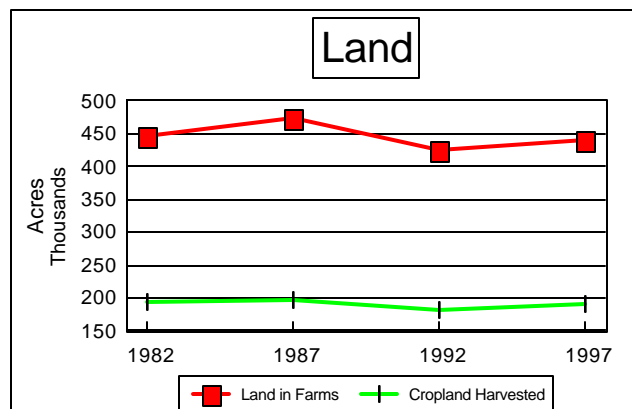
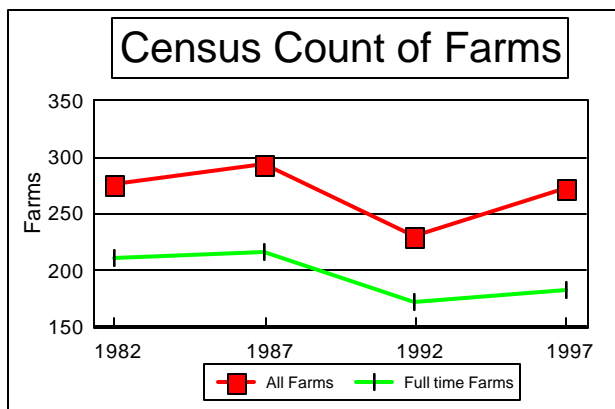
Increased 29 percent to \$122,580,000 in 1997.
